

## FOUND LAKE ASSOCIATION SPRING 2018 NEWS

The Association will be conducting our Annual Meeting on JULY 7 at 11AM followed by our paid picnic. The meeting and picnic will be conducted at Vandervort Park on Lost Lake. That same day lake residents will be participating in a boat parade beginning at 6:45 at the Pierce dock. Prizes will be presented to the winning boat decorations for the holiday,

This year the Association will again be participating in a college intern program of 230 hours to conduct boat landing inspections. As well a number of residents will be volunteering 110 hours to augment the program. This program is funded through a DNR grant. As a result of the resident volunteers, this program operates at no cost to the Association.

The Association has contracted with Onterra to conduct an Early Season Aquatic Invasive Species survey in June and early July as we had done 3 years ago. Found Lake has remained free of Aquatic Invasive Species of plants to far. We are hoping to see similar results again this year.

The heavy snows this past winter along with the snow melt run off from feeder streams and swamps have led to considerable water staining this spring.

This past fall the DNR stocked approximately 1600 large fingerling walleye into Found.

As the cold snowy spring moves into what appears to be a warm summer, residents are looking toward a great summer season out on the lake.
