

What's Happening Outside Wisconsin

Successful:

- Oregon: State law covering part of Wilamette River (weight limits)
- Vermont: Pending citizen action on a state agency rulemaking:
 - 1000' from shore rule
 - Very different procedure than in Wisconsin
 - Still could be shut down by their legislature

Less successful:

- Minnesota: Two legislative actions didn't pass
 - 250' from shore rule
 - Wake education as part of boating certificate
- New Hampshire: 250' rule did not pass

- 4) Is the damage only coming from enhanced wakes?




