RELATING TO SMOKE FREE TOWN
BUILDINGS AND MOTOR VEHICLES

WHEREAS, the town of Saint Germain is committed to providing a healthy and safe environment for its employees and the public; and

WHEREAS, the United States Surgeon General declared in a 1986 report on involuntary smoking that:

- o Involuntary smoking is a cause of disease, including lung cancer, in healthy non-smokers
- o The simple separation of smokers and non-smokers within the same air space may reduce, but does not eliminate, the exposure of non-smokers to environmental tobacco smoke

and


WHEREAS, the Vilas County Public Health Department is encouraging all Vilas County town boards to adopt a smoke free policy for public buildings and vehicles,




- o Offices

- o Community work areas


