MINUTES ANNUAL BUDGET HEARING: NOVEMBER 30, 2009

Call to Order: The chairman called the Annual Budget Hearing to order at 7:00 P.M. It was noted that this was a duly called meeting in accordance with the Wisconsin Open Meeting Law.

Board Members Present: Peggy Nimz, Todd Wiese, Fred Radtke, John Vojta, Lee Christensen, Marion Janssen, town treasurer, Tom Martens, town clerk. There were also nine other people in attendance.

Budget for 2010: Ms. Nimz read through the proposed budget for 2010. She then asked for questions from the floor. Carol Radtke asked why the fair market values were listed on the tax bills. She thought that it made things more confusing.

The clerk explained that at this time he had not received the state school credit from the Department of Revenue. Without it, the mill rate appeared to be around \$9.40 per \$1,000 of assessed value.

There were no other comments about items in the budget. The proposed tax levy is \$800,041.
