- a. Approval of the 2020-2021 alcohol related licenses. Motion by Cooper to approve operator's license as presented for Sister's Saloon and temporary picnic license for Chamber's two events; second Swenson. Discussion none. By a voice vote; 4-0. Discussion on approval of operator's license with felony. Per Town's Association attorney if it were a distribution charge would have to look at it differently. Was the possession related to the business of serving alcohol? Applicant could sue in which the town would be responsible for attorney/court fees. Safe thing is to err on the side of caution and approve license. Courts trend favorably on siding with the applicant and not discriminate on prior convictions.
