- WHEREAS the lakes in Saint Germain are important resources used by the public for recreation and enjoyment of natural beauty; and
- WHEREAS the Town Lakes Committee has been created for the purpose of developing programs to assist town lake organizations and lake users in the responsible and holistic long range management of town lakes; and
- WHEREAS the Town Lakes Committee desires to continue its efforts to inform the public of the risks of aquatic invasive species and to instill in all lake users an understanding of good lake stewardship practices; and
- WHEREAS the Town Lakes Committee has conducted grant funded aquatic invasive species awareness campaigns for the past four summers and is qualified to carry out the responsibilities of this project,
- WHERAS the Town of Saint Germain requests the funds and assistance available from the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources under the "AIS Control Grant Program"; now therefore,
- BE IT RESOLVED that Todd Wiese, Town Board Vice Chairman and Town Lakes Committee Liaison, to act on behalf of the Town of Saint Germain to: submit an application to the State of Wisconsin for financial aid for lake planning purposes; sign documents; and take necessary action to undertake, direct, and complete an approved planning grant.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Town of Saint Germain will meet the obligations of the project including timely publication of the results and meet the financial obligations under this grant including the prompt payment of its 25% commitment to planning project costs.

We understand the importance of a continuing management program for lakes in Saint Germain and intend to proceed on that course.
